This infosheet provides a quick overview of how DairyTrace makes dairy cattle traceability easy for terminal sites.



DAIRYTRACE ROLE IN TRACEABILITY

DairyTrace is Canada's dairy cattle traceability program. Traceability data collected by DairyTrace is stored for emergency management and other industry value-added purposes. This information is required by the **Federal Government as Part XV of the Health of Animals Regulations** of dairy cattle animals in Canada under the direction of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA).

REPORTING TRACEABILITY EVENTS

There are two options for value-chain participants to report traceability events for dairy cattle, DairyTrace and the Canadian Cattle Identification Agency (CCIA). All regulated parties that report federal events for both CCIA and DairyTrace tags, are required to have an account in both databases. There are reporting processes and tools available to assist with reporting to both locations.
